The concept of 'birthing consciousness,' a distinct and predominantly positive psycho-physical altered state experienced by women during natural childbirth, akin to other altered states of consciousness induced by decreased prefrontal cortex activity. Birthing consciousness exemplifies an adaptive pain-induced altered state associated with transient hypofrontality: Given the historical significance of successful natural childbirth for maternal and infant survival, the ability to access birthing consciousness likely contributed to their survival prior to obstetric interventions. Natural birth, characterized by intense pain, correlates with the brain's hypofrontality mechanism, which reduces pain and enhances other cognitive and phenomenological aspects, thus promoting optimal birth outcomes.
